#### FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE

#### INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

Every Victorian child should have access to the world of learning opportunities that exist beyond the classroom. The Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund helps ensure that no student will miss out on the opportunity to join their classmates for important, educational and fun activities. It is part of making Victoria the Education State and the Government's commitment to breaking the link between a student's background and their outcomes.

#### CAMPS, SPORTS & EXCURSIONS FUND (CSEF)

School camps provide children with inspiring experiences in the great outdoors. Excursions encourage a deeper understanding of how the world works while sports teach teamwork, discipline and leadership. All are a part of a healthy curriculum.

CSEF is provided by the Victorian Government to assist eligible families to cover the costs of school trips, camps and sporting activities.

If you hold a valid means-tested concession card or are a temporary foster parent, you may be eligible for CSEF. A special consideration category also exists for asylum seeker and refugee families. The allowance is paid to the school to use towards expenses relating to camps, excursions or sporting activities for the benefit of your child.

The annual CSEF amount per student is:

- · \$154 for primary school students
- \$256 for secondary school students

#### HOW TO APPLY

New applicants should contact the school office to obtain a CSEF application form or download from the website below.

If you applied for CSEF at your child's school last year, you do not need to complete an application form this year unless there has been a change in your family circumstances.

You only need to complete an application form if any of the following changes have occurred:

- **new student enrolments**: your child has started or changed schools this year.
- changed family circumstances: such as a change of custody, change of name, concession card number, or new siblings commencing this year.

#### **Term 1 Student Support Group Meetings:**

On Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> and Wednesday 26<sup>th</sup> February, we are holding our term 1 Student Support Group Meetings for all students at Dillbadin Primary School. Meetings will be held onsite between 3:30 and 5:30.

The purpose of these meetings is to:

- meet your child's teacher for 2025
- discuss how the year will look for your child
- gain an insight into the learning opportunities your child is involved in at school
- collaborate and brainstorm some goals your child may work on throughout the year
- ask any questions you may have
- share information about your child that will help us support your child throughout the school day

These SSG meetings are held each term at Dillbadin Primary School. In terms 2 and 3, the focus of the meetings is to discuss your child's continued progress towards their learning goals. In term 4, meetings are focused on a celebration of the achievements each child has made and making recommendations for the following school year.

SSG meetings are booked via your Compass portal and run for no more than 20 minutes each.

#### Compass: Late Arrivals (after 9:15am) and Early Departures

All students must be signed in and out by parents at the office using the Compass 'Kiosk' (iPad). This will automatically update class rolls. Students being collected early will be called to the office by staff where they will be collected by parents/carers. Parents are not to go directly to the classroom unless requested by staff.

#### **Compass - Absence Notifications**

All student absences must be explained by parents using Compass. Parents are asked to please ensure that the correct time date and time frame is selected when sending absence notifications. Compass has two sessions: AM (9:00am – 12:00pm) and PM (12:30pm – 3:30pm). Please be careful with selecting the appropriate dates and times for the duration of your child's absence.


